SKIN PRICK TESTING (SPT) is easy to perform

-  The results are available on the day of the procedure and many different allergens can be tested, if required.
-  Patients will be required to make an appointment for this service that will be performed under the supervision of an Allergist/Immunologist.
-  A report with the results will also be forwarded to the referring doctor.
-  For patients intending to undertake a skin prick test, please do not take antihistamines for at least 3 days prior to your appointment as this will interfere with SPT.
